

These changes are made outside of the ACE editor.

Links, headers, colors and bar text can all be changed with easy editing and a quick FTP upload.

To add, change or rename links and headers

When adding, changing or renaming links and headers, open and edit the following files located in the root folder (usually public_html):

- Links
 1. Top navigation bar in “header-links.php”
 2. Bottom navigation bar in “footer-link.php”
 3. Side links in “main_link.php”, “product_link.php”, “video_link.php”
- Headers
 1. Left and right headers can be changed respectively in “left_php” and “right_php”.
- Text in the colored bars on the tops of the pages can be edited in the db file. The db file is in root/admin/includes/db.php
 1. Open db file
 2. On lines 14-24 are the titles EBay Products-Latest Products in red text. Make any desired changes to the titles and upload the db file back into the includes folder.

The above files can be edited with any homepage editing software and uploaded back to a site root.

To change color and text

Use the following folders and files to change color and text:

- **Images folder** - This file, located in the root folder, is fully editable and can change the entire site color design.
 1. Various colors and styles to change site appearance are located in the members’ area of ACE Site Creator.
 2. After downloading a selected color, the contents of these files can be uploaded to a server root to make site changes. They can also be uploaded into the admin folder to change the admin colors. If the header image has already been uploaded, **FIRST** save a copy on a hard drive since it will be overwritten.
- **CSS file**

This file (style.css) is used to edit text and other site colors that are not edited by changes to the image folder.

All other colors in a site are editable with the style.css document located in the root

folder (usually public_html) by changing the color codes (some color codes are listed below and others can be found with programs like Photoshop). To change colors, open the style.css document. Different color codes are listed after the # marks. Change the color code for any link or part of a site to be modified. Next, upload the style.css document to the root directory and overwrite the previous one.

The approximate color codes for the ACE styles in the members' area are as follows (codes for each color vary with shade):

Black-#5A5A5A

Blue-#1A3DB3

Dark Red-#751111

Green-#54A91A

Light Blue-#37F89

Light Purple-#EC92EA

Orange-#B57901

Pink-#EC92EA

Red-#8A1315

The codes on each line can be changed to any color on the CSS Style Sheet. Following is a guide to various CSS lines and the corresponding location where color can be changed:

2 remove this line to change the upper part of the outer sidebars

4 lower part of outer sidebars

8 inner part of side bars

19 main body color

82 top bar text (pre hover)

86 top bar hover text

103 middle of page text apart from parts in line 113

113 middle of page text such as product titles, bid now, watch list (if EBay page)

128 text inside of colored center bars

194 title text in right side bars

228 right side text (pre hover)

234 right side hover text

265 latest products (if added)

270 description of latest products (pre hover, if added)

276 description of latest products (hover, if added)

289 title text in left side bars (main-sponsor)

325 left link text (home-images, pre hover)

331 left link text (hover)

340-354 lines above footer

354 top part of footer

364 remove this line to change the upper part of the footer

367 bottom half of footer

401 footer text (pre hover)

407 footer text (hover)

416 bottom footer text

Always backup the style sheet before experimenting with color codes.
